



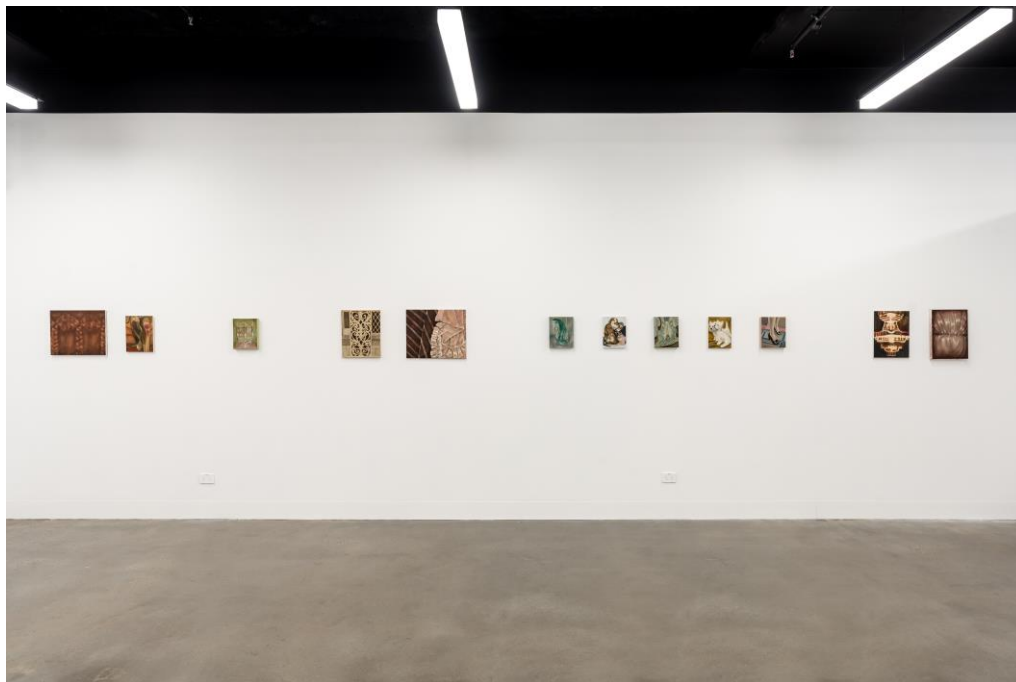

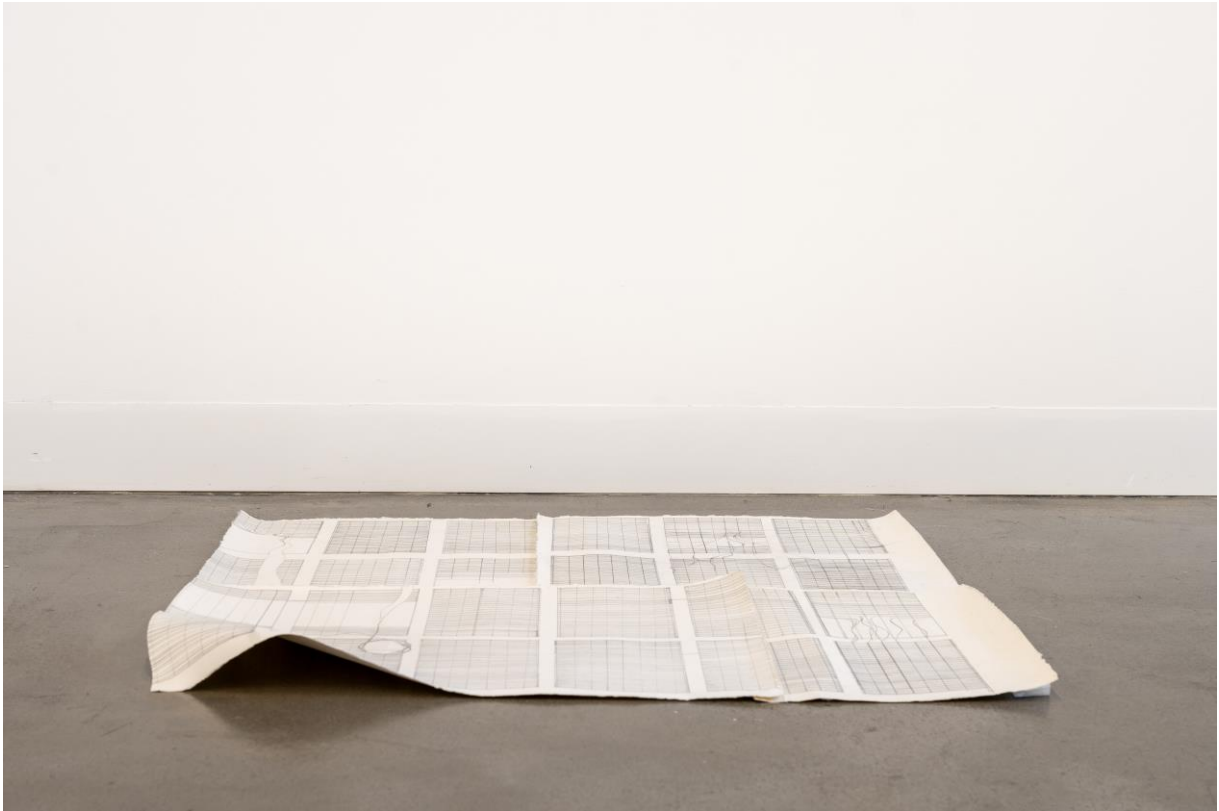
NABIS2K
