Terms of Reference

Purpose The Associate Dean International has delegated authority from the Dean to provide academic leadership of the development and implementation of the Faculty's international strategy, ensuring its consistency with relevant Faculty and University strategies. To assist them in this role, they are aided by the Faculty's International Committee, which advises and works with the Associate Dean on developing new – and nurturing existing – strategic international partnerships that enhance the distinctive experience of the staff and students who work in and with the Faculty and that advance the interests of the staff and students of the Faculty.

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1. Faculty strategy:
 - a) to develop and implement the Faculty's international strategy
 - b) to provide a forum for the consideration of initiatives raised in Schools that have an international dimension
 - c) to support the Associate Dean International in influencing and responding to the University's international strategy, as well as Commonwealth and State Government initiatives in internationalisation
 2. Education and students:
 - a) to identify areas for improved delivery of an internationalised curriculum and student experience, working with the Education and Students portfolio to identify opportunities for international innovation and leadership in teaching and learning
 - b) to identify and support the international opportunities available to all students in the Faculty
 - c) to work with the Education and Students portfolio and the Future Students team to increase the international appeal of the Faculty's teaching programs
 - d) to identify University of Melbourne Overseas Subject (UMOS) opportunities, especially those that advance international strategic objectives
 3. Partnerships:
 - a) to identify and build international partnerships that advance the interests of the Faculty's staff and students, in collaboration with the Partnerships portfolio, the Manager International Strategy, and the Future Students team
 - b) to identify opportunities to engage with international industry and community partners, focusing on increasing international recognition for the Faculty's role in engagement internationally and within the University
 - c) to enhance the profile of our international alumni, building them into our international work
 4. Indigenous:
 - a) to advance, working with the Indigenous portfolio, the international opportunities available to Indigenous staff and students, consistent with and pursuant to the relevant Faculty and University strategy in this area
 5. Research:
 - a) to identify and enhance, working with the Research portfolio, opportunities for high-impact international collaboration through targeted support, including in strategic areas where supported collaboration is viable and sustainable
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Reports The Committee reports to the Faculty Management Committee.

Reporting Strategic working groups chaired by the relevant Deputy Associate Dean (International) report to the Committee.
