

Clubs and Societies Regulation Amendment Proposal March 2026

Preamble:

In council 3(26), an amendment to R6.3.h was passed which amended the minimum membership number for disciplinary action from thirty members to forty members. This was passed in a motion which moved a group of amendments regarding activity reporting requirements, as it was incorrectly grouped and instead should have been included in a motion for minimum membership amendments. The committee has moved to revoke this amendment as without the other minimum membership amendments being passed, this change alone is inconsistent with the rest of the regulations and does not have any effect. Revoking this change restores consistency within the regulations.
