Current Clause:

“Attendance List” and “Event Attendance List” means either:

- (i) A record of attendance taken on the form available from the C&S Office or Clubs Online, that includes the name, student number, course and signature of all those attending; or
- (ii) A handwritten list including all the details of (i) but not on the C&S form; or
- (iii) An electronic attendance record taken at the event that includes the name, student number, course and a timestamp of arrival; or
- (iv) A report from the UMSU website of tickets purchased for an event that were only available during the event.

Proposed Clause:

“Attendance List” and “Event Attendance List” means either:

- (i) A record of attendance taken on the form available from the C&S Office or Clubs Online, that includes the name, student number and signature of all those attending; or
- (ii) A handwritten list including all the details of (i) but not on the C&S form; or
- (iii) An electronic attendance record taken at the event that includes the name, student number and the timestamp of arrival; or
- (iv) A report from the UMSU website of tickets purchased for an event that were only available during the event.

- (i) includes the day on which notice is given if that day is an Academic Day and the Notice is given before 5.15 pm, and
- (ii) does not include the day for which notice is given, unless the meeting commences after 5.15 pm.

Proposed

1. INTRODUCTION

(h) Unless otherwise specified, in these Regulations a notice period specified in Academic Days:

- (i) includes the day on which notice is given if that day is an Academic Day and the Notice is given before 6 pm, and

(ii) does not include the day for which notice is given, unless the meeting commences after 6 pm.

Reasoning:

Updates the definition of an academic day for the purpose of notice to reflect more accurately reflect when classes run.

It is worth noting that the constitution does have a definition for academic day, however it is worse than useless for this purpose being defined as “has the meaning adopted by the University.” Which I couldn’t find said meaning for the life of me, It is my interpretation that this refers to only which days are teaching days and not the start and end time of said day.

9.3. High Risk Events

Recent discussions between Staff and the insurer have led to new obligations to report to Insurer all of the following, and need to define them as high risk:

- Any event at which alcohol is provided (whether by the club or licenced venue)
- Camp

- Cruise / Ball / Cocktail Night / Event hosted at a night club
