Club had an AGM and experienced hostile behaviour from a group of people who attended together. According to various observations, they interrupted reports and speeches, made speeches focused on business and profit, and nominated and voted for each other for all positions.

Committee is against stacking, but cannot really regulate it. Club had an anti-stacking provision (candidates must have been members for 14 days), but the Returning Officer did not properly adhere to it due to the hostile environment of the general meeting. Therefore, the constitution was breached and two people who had only been members for 12 days were elected.

ACTION: Melanie and Esther to put in a bulletin that inappropriate behaviour at an AGM should be reported and security can be called, and that an AGM can be closed if the environment is unsafe.

To prevent stacking, clubs should hold frequent events for members to generate genuine interest in the club so that they actively participate in the AGM.

Esther asks to change the word 'feels' to 'determines' in Josh's new clubs affiliation regulation change proposal.

Discussion on incorporating the 250 club cap into Josh's regulation change proposals to prevent future committees from bending the rules for their own interests. It is safer to implement a cap as default and allow future committees to make decisions surrounding that.
