2.2. Update on Art Relaxation Event and Drawing Packs

The workshop went well and payments have been finalised for the workshop facilitator, as well as the Drawing Pack vouchers that have been distributed to all attendees so that they can continue the art therapy practices demonstrated in the workshop at home.

2.3. Update on Mutual Aid Vouchers

The vouchers were sent out to all 53 women and non-binary students who signed-up to receive them, and the Women's Department got some very wholesome messages back in response.

2.4. Update on Judy's Punch

The 2021 edition of Judy's Punch has been finalised, printed, and posted! We had our launch party via Zoom on October 22. We've also finally received two separate

tax invoices from the printers, for printing (\$8794.50) as well as postage (\$448.91). The Women's Department is seeking to pass money to pay these off.

It should be noted that previously, the Women's Committee passed \$3000 for shipping as we believed that international postage would be much more expensive that it turned out to be.
