

Hi there Ryan and Teresa,

It's so lovely to hear from you!

So firstly, I operate out of Canberra but I shall make trips to Melbourne regularly! I unfortunately won't be able to make it for your O-Week either as I will be in ACT, NSW (regional), SA and WA.

But I wanted to say that I'd be up for a call before then! In fact, I will be in Melbourne on the 27th (this week) if you wanted to meet in the afternoon.

I thought I'd just give you a brief campaign outline, as you know, I am running a campaign titled **Your Rights at Work, Uni and Home** (feel free to like the Facebook Page). At present the campaign is focused on Centrelink and I am running a petition with a number of demands that is gathering signatures fast. The campaign throughout the year will also address

- Centrelink
- Penalty rates
- Exploitation of casual workers
- Unpaid/underpaid internships
- Disability support
- Carer support
- On-campus mental health services
- Housing

The reason for the broad campaign is many of these things are interconnected and a unified branding for the year will be much more cohesive.

The multiple aims will also allow for more inclusion from campuses, and allow individual student unions to address issues of particular relevance/importance to their campus, tying them into a broad student rights campaign. I.e. If campuses run off-shoot campaigns, they can include the NUS logo and the campaign logo to increase chances of media coverage.

Therefore, under these themes there is plenty of space to have collaboration.

Moreover concurrently to this major campaign, I will be running a body image and body positivity campaign in collaboration with the Butterfly foundation. Butterfly hold two major events in the year, one is in May and the other is in September. Both of these work to raise awareness to the prevalence of eating disorders and bringing about body positivity.

I will be collaborating with them to raise awareness for these issues and to build a university focus. Further, the campaign will call on and assist campuses to have more information and help available for these issues.


