# 2022 ELECTION REPORT

## **1. Introduction**

In 2022, the University of Melbourne Student Union (**UMSU**) engaged OGL Group to conduct their Annual Elections.

Gavin Ryan was the Returning Officer for the 2022 Annual General Elections and is the author of this report.

This report sets out the process by which the elections were undertaken, specifically highlighting areas that required attention by the Returning Officer and electoral participants. An overview of the results is provided, emphasising trends and other observations. The key issues and other areas of concern experienced in the election are discussed in detail. Finally, a set of recommendations are provided to UMSU as suggestions by which the electoral process can be improved.

## 2. Process

In 2021, the UMSU Student Council amended its Constitution and passed and secured an updated set of Election Regulations (**Regulations**) that governed the conduct of these elections. This allowed the elections to be held by either using a fully online election model or a hybrid in-person campaigning and online voting model. In accordance with provisions in the Constitution and Regulations, the dates of polling were set down as the first full academic week in September, with other election deadlines being consequently set as stipulated by provisions in the Regulations and the Constitution. These election timelines and relevant information were publicised through both notice of the election and election information sent to members.

Pursuant to the Regulations, notice was given on 22 July 2022 that the Annual Elections would be held from Monday 5 September to Friday 9 September 2022 (see [Appendix 1 – Notice of Election](#)), with nominations due on Friday 12 August. Notice of the election was posted on the UMSU website, sent out via the UMSU member email, and the subject of social media posts on official UMSU accounts. No by-elections were necessitated in the 2022 UMSU Annual Elections.

Election paperwork could be submitted directly to the Returning Officer via email and in the case of nomination forms, a Google form was also made available for students to nominate electronically on the election website.

### Tickets

Ticket registrations were opened at 12pm on Monday 25 July and closed at midday on Friday 12 August. Nine ticket registrations were received in total.

### Nominations

Nominations were opened at 12pm on Monday 25 July and closed at midday on Friday 12 August.

After the closing of nominations, a detailed verification process was undertaken to ensure that candidates and their nominators and seconders were eligible to participate in the election by virtue of their enrolment as a University of Melbourne student, their UMSU membership and other position specific requirements as provided for in the Constitution and the Regulations.

Once eligibility checks with UMSU and the University had concluded, the final notice of nominations received was posted on Friday 19 August 2022 (see [Appendix 2 – Notice of Nominations Received & Accepted](#)).

The verification process resulted in six nominations being determined ineligible, with the majority being due to the candidate not being an UMSU General Member at the time of nominations closing. This is a lower number compared to the 2021 UMSU Elections, where 15 nominations were deemed ineligible.

Upon the close of nominations, there were no nominations for the Indigenous and Southbank students’ representatives on council. All other positions had at least one valid nomination received.

The following positions received an amount of nominations equal or lesser than the vacancies for that position and hence were declared elected unopposed: Activities Officer, Media Officers, Clubs & Societies Officer, Indigenous Officer, Disabilities Officer, Southbank Education Officer, Southbank Activities Officer, Southbank Campus Coordinator, Burnley Campus Coordinator, Indigenous Committee, Southbank Campus Committee and Burnley Campus Committee.

**At the close of the nomination and ticket registration periods:**

- **9 tickets had been successfully registered**
- **296 nominations had been received**
- **6 nominations were invalid**
- **9 Office-bearer positions and 3 Committees were elected unopposed**
- **Two positions received no nominations**

**Polling**

Polling was conducted using the BigPulse voting system. All students on the Electoral Roll provided by the University received an email at the opening of polling with a personal voting link that would take them to their ballot.

A reminder email was sent to all voters that had not already cast a vote at midday Wednesday 7 September, and at 9am Friday 9 September (as highlighted below). The following table summarises the times during which students cast their votes, with spikes in voting following each reminder email being sent.

### **3. Results**

#### **Declarations**

Results were counted and verified in the presence of scrutineers following the close of voting, and provisionally declared on the 9<sup>th</sup> September. These were then declared as final after verification by the electoral tribunal on Thursday 15 September 2022, with the notice made available on the UMSU website and sent to all candidates via email (see [Appendix 3 – Notice of Results](#)).

All successful candidates were also required to fill out a declaration stating that they were not disqualified from managing a corporation by the *Corporations Act 2001 (Cth)* or from being a governing committee member by the Australian Charities and Not for Profits Commission as required by the UMSU Constitution. Candidates were required to submit this declaration to me prior to results being finalised by the electoral tribunal.

#### **Participation**

The 2021 election recorded a similar number of students voting compared to recent contested elections, with 5,158 voters casting votes over the five days. This represented 8.7% of eligible students. Many voters did not cast a vote in all of the three poll groups, with 3,755 voters (6.3%) voting in the office-bearer elections, 3,306 voters (5.6%) voting in the UMSU Students' Council election and 3,106 (5.2%) voting in the National Union of Students delegate election. Students did not have to vote in all ballots in particular ballot groups, and hence were able to lodge blank votes rather than fill in all ballots shown in each group (leaving boxes blank), and this resulted in small percentages of informal votes much smaller than paper ballot equivalents.

### **4. Issues & Recommendations**

This section deals with specific problems which arose with the election process or logistics along with recommendations that arise from these issues. It is not intended to be an exhaustive account of each issue that became necessary for the Returning Officer to consider.

#### **Candidate Membership Requirements**

The UMSU Electoral Regulations mandate that all candidates standing for election must be General members of UMSU. However, this stands in contradiction with the UMSU Constitutions which only mandates that Office Bearers need be UMSU General Members by the beginning of the polling period. This results in a situation where a more onerous membership requirement is placed on candidates to UMSU Committees and National Union of Students Delegates. While this does not have a significant impact on the conduct of the election (almost all Office Bearer candidates were UMSU members prior to the close of nominations) the inconsistency between the regulations and constitution remains.

#### **Recommendation 1**

*That UMSU amend its constitution to either delegate UMSU membership requirements to stand for election to the electoral regulations or specify membership requirements to stand for all positions.*

### **Polling Place Requirements**

The UMSU Electoral Regulations mandate a number of polling places where polling must be conducted. With online voting, this gives students accessibility to polling through their devices wherever they are and at any time in the election period. It has now been the experience that election staff present at polling booth in a hybrid online voting and in person campaigning model are used mainly for assistance with access to the voting link and other election matters much more than providing students with a physical place to vote.

In light of this, the mandating of physical polling spaces should be reviewed given the purpose of making voting accessible through the provision of access to polling has been superseded by the polling access changing. The locations have also not been updated for many years and the Union House location will cease to be an option in future due to campus redevelopment.

### **Recommendation 2**

*That UMSU review the polling place requirements under R27.9 of the Election Regulations to assess what physical polling places are required with online polling access.*

## **5. Conclusion**

This year's elections saw UMSU hold their annual elections in a hybrid in-person campaigning /online voting for the first time. The UMSU framework governing the election largely worked well with this election format, and students participated in election activities both online and in-person format easily and straightforwardly.

Thanks go to all the staff involved in running the elections, including our OGL Group staff, and especially UMSU and University staff who assisted in various ways throughout the election. In particular my thanks go to Phoebe Churches, Ciara Griffiths, Aillish Hannan, Dee Jarret, Greg Shea and Peter Strong for their assistance throughout the election process. I would also like to acknowledge Joanna Guellas for her invaluable assistance in putting together the election guide and organising the presidential candidates' debate.

## **ELIGIBILITY TO STAND**

Any University of Melbourne student may nominate for any position unless otherwise specified.

- Any Officer position may be held by two persons jointly except the positions of President, General Secretary, Media Officer, the Burnley Campus Co-ordinator the Southbank Students Campus Co-ordinator the Southbank Activities Officer and the Southbank Education Officer.
- The position of Media Officer will be held jointly by no less than three and no more than four persons, at least one of whom must be a Woman.

Pursuant to clause 6.1 of the Electoral Regulations:

- The Women’s Officer and the voting representatives of the Women’s Committee must be a Woman.

- The Voting Council Representative elected by Queer Students, the Queer Officer and the voting representatives of the Queer Committee must be Queer Students.
- If the position of Queer Officer is not held jointly, the Queer Officer must be a Woman, Trans or Non-Binary.
- If the position of Queer Officer is held jointly, one of the persons holding the position must be a Woman, Trans or Non-Binary.
- If the position of Women's Officer is held jointly, at least one of the persons holding the position must be a Woman of Colour.
- If any other Officer position is held jointly, one of the persons holding the position must be a Woman.
- The Voting Council Representative elected by Indigenous Students, the Indigenous Officer and the voting representatives of the Indigenous Committee must be Indigenous Students.
- The Voting Council Representative elected by Students with Disabilities, Disabilities Officer and the voting representatives of the Disabilities Committee must be Students with Disabilities.
- The Voting Council Representative elected by Students of Colour, People of Colour Officer and the voting representatives of the People of Colour Committee must be Students of Colour.
- The Voting Council Representative elected by International Students must be a person who is an International Student.
- The Voting Council Representative elected by Graduate Students must be a person who is a Graduate Student.
- The Voting Council Representative elected by Southbank Campus Students, the Southbank Students Campus Co-ordinator, Southbank Activities Officer, Southbank Education Officer, and the voting representatives of the Southbank Students Committee must be Southbank Campus Students.

### **RECEIPT OF NOMINATIONS**

Nominations should be submitted via this [google form](#). Students wishing to nominate via soft copy form will find a link available on the UMSU Election webpage. Students wishing to nominate for the positions of Disabilities Officer, Committee or Voting Council Representative; People of Colour Officer, Committee of Voting Council Representative; Queer Officer, Committee or Voting Council Representative; or Women's Officer, Committee, must also indicate on their nomination forms that they identify with their restricted constituency.

### **WITHDRAWAL OF NOMINATIONS**

A candidate may withdraw their nomination at any time before the start of counting for their position. The withdrawal form is available on the [UMSU election webpage](#). Please email your signed withdrawal form to [returningofficer@union.unimelb.edu.au](mailto:returningofficer@union.unimelb.edu.au). Electronic signatures will be accepted.

### **TICKET REGISTRATIONS**

Applications to register a ticket name must be accompanied with the signatures of 15 UMSU General Members. Tickets that are running candidates for multi-member positions must also submit a form showing the order in which they wish their candidates to appear. Electronic signatures will be accepted. Ticket registrations and re-registrations open Monday 25 July at 12:00 pm and close Friday 12 August at 12:00 pm. Ticket registrations submitted prior to the opening of ticket registrations will each be considered as if they have been received at the exact time of the opening. In the case of multiple registrations of the same name, the name registered first will take precedence and if tickets are registered at the same time, the registrant will be determined by lot.

Ticket registration and candidate order forms must be submitted by close of nominations and are available on the [UMSU election webpage](#).

### **POLICY STATEMENTS AND CANDIDATE PHOTOS**

Each candidate may submit a statement that must be no more than 300 words for Office Bearers and no more than 100 words for all other positions. Candidates to the University of Melbourne Council may submit a statement no longer than 200 words which will be reviewed by the University Secretary. Each ticket registrant with an approved ticket may submit a policy statement that must be no more than 1000 words. These statements should be delivered via email to the returning officer email address. If candidates wish to have candidate photos taken, they must arrange for that themselves. Candidate photos and policy statements must be submitted prior to the close of nominations.

### **UNIVERSITY COUNCIL MEMBER NOMINATIONS**

Candidates for the University Council member position must complete and submit with their nomination a [Victorian Statutory Declaration](#) and [TEQSA Fit and Proper Person Declaration](#). If you are submitting your nomination via google form, these documents are linked in the form and you can upload them using the form. The Victorian Statutory Declaration must include that you are:

- *are enrolled in an award course at the University of Melbourne;*
- *understand that they must remain so during their term as a member, otherwise the membership ceases; and*
- *have at least 12 months of expected enrolment from the date of the election to complete the relevant award.*

## **VOTING SESSION**

Voting will open 10:00 am on Monday 5 September 2022 and close 5:00 pm on Friday 9 September 2022. Voting will be conducted via the BigPulse platform, with an individual voting link sent to all eligible voters via their student email at the beginning of the voting session. Voters will also be able to vote in person, using electronic devices, at the following places and times:
