How does this event benefit students?

The Rural Ball provides a social event for our members who live in a number of towns across rural Victoria. Many of our members live alone on solo placements in very small towns, working long hours and moving around Victoria constantly to fulfil placement requirements. This can be very isolating. The ball gives these students, and all students, an opportunity to reconnect with and socialise with their peers, providing a break from the stressful clinical placements of medical school.

We make a small loss overall on this event as we significantly subsidise ticket sales to maximise accessibility to students, and this assistance in funding would allow us to ensure that we can include all students who want to attend.
