All positions barring Vice President (Education and Welfare) and Partnership and Sponsorship Director were declared elected at 7:30 pm on Friday 21st May. Vice President (Education and Welfare) and Partnership and Sponsorship Director were declared elected at 8.30am on Monday 24th May after a review of the order of the count by the Returning Officer to ensure results were in line with candidates stated preferences for positions in accordance with the order of counting as stated.
